And he says: »I want my head to be bathed by the dust that falls from the lotus feet of any of Vraja's residents. Their entire life and soul is the supreme personality of Godhead, Mukunda, the dust of whose lotus feet is still being searched for in the Vedic mantras.«

Just think about it: Brahma – the creator of the universe, the greatest person, greater than any person we know in this world, who has designed everything, who is the master of all the demigods – this Brahma wants to go to Vrindavan to get the dust of Krishna's lotus feet. But how does he want it?
