Welcome to today's Kartik inspirations. We are discussing the miracles in Vrindavan.

For instance, in the spiritual world, Srila Visvanath Cakravarti Thakur is Sri Radha's maidservant Vinod Manjari, or Vinoda Vallabhi Manjari. It is said that once Krishna appeared to Srila Visvanath Cakravarti Thakur and ordered him to make commentaries on the books of the six Goswamis.
